The following is a report from your parish's outreach efforts for October.

The SVdP Assistance line handled 18 calls and provided assistance to 3 families. Total assistance provided for rent, mortgage, electric and other services was **\$1.908**. Monetary donations in the amount of \$2,845 were received from St. Matthew's, St. Patrick's & Friends of our St. Vincent de Paul Society.

St. Matthew's Food Pantry served 108 families (representing 328 individuals); 4,815 lbs. of food were distributed to parish families and others. Food was also distributed to Enoch Manor.

Food Donations were received from St. Patrick's Church, St. Matthew's Church, Panera Bread, Catholic Charities, Lee Hill Community Center, and Fredericksburg Regional Food Bank & USDA, totaling 9,320 lbs.

St. Matthew's Baby Closet served 33 families with a combined total of 155 individuals. Several baby items were distributed valued at \$1,320.00. Items included assorted clothing, formula, lotion, shampoo, blankets, baby wash, baby bottles, diapers, and diaper rash lotion.

Our Good Samaritans were unable to visit our homebound parishioners due to the pandemic, but reached out to them by email and telephone.
